Last week in Y3, we carried on with our topic of the Stone Age. We watched a short video from an expert on how Stone Age people made tools and the materials that they used to make them. We learned that you can make a very strong rope from nettles! After that, we worked in pairs to find things out ourselves from pictures about life in a Stone Age camp. We then used this information to write a report with sub-headings.

In maths, we carried on with our learning of place value – 1 more/less, 10 more/less and 100 more/less than a number before solving problems and reasoning about Place Value.

We had our first computing lesson last Thursday afternoon. First of all we need to make sure that everybody could login to a laptop on the school system before logging into Purplemash and completing the 2Do's that had been set for maths and science. Purplemash can be used at home as well as in school and it's the same login. These logins will be sent home very soon.
