Dear Everybody,

We had another busy week in Year 3 last week. In French, we had a practical session where we practised the numbers 1 to 10 by working in small groups. We made a French version of the game 'hopscotch'. In these groups we used chalk to mark out our boxes before writing the French numbers in words in them. We then tested our games by saying the numbers out loud as we landed on them.

In P.E we started to look at overloads in netball by playing small games where teams have more attackers than defenders. In this session the children were particularly good at passing quickly. As a class we talked about the word deception means, and how we could use it in sports such as netball, hockey, and football to trick our opponents.

In maths we started to apply our knowledge of addition and subtraction by solving problems and in literacy, we have planned our own stories around the 'Three Little Pigs' and we will be writing them this week.

This week in maths, we will be continuing to learn about time on Monday followed by addition, subtraction and statistics.

We have now finished our wonderful science topic of 'Rocks and Soils' and we now move to 'Magnets and Forces.'
