Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year! I hope you and your children enjoyed the Christmas break and it is great to see everyone back at school.

I am writing to inform you of the Lucid Rapid computer program that we have begun to use to screen children for dyslexia in a bid to ensure that any potential needs are identified and so that relevant support can be provided to assist learning. Initially, we are working with children in Years 5 and 6.

As the online information explains, the program is relatively quick and very child friendly and children will be guided through the process by a member of staff. Once the activities are completed, a short report will be compiled that indicates a likelihood or not of dyslexia with a sliding scale of 1-7 with 1 being greatest risk of dyslexia and 7 being least risk.

If we feel that further support may be required for your child, either your child's class teacher or I will contact you to discuss this. Equally, if your child has completed an assessment and you wish to see the report regardless, please contact me.
