**School Clubs – 20 February 2023 – 31 March 2023**

We have details of the after-school clubs starting on our return to school in January 2023.

If you would like to reserve a place at one of the following clubs, please make a payment on your ParentPay account no later than **Wednesday 8 February**. You will **not** be able to sign up to clubs after this date. This enables us to decide if the club will be running, if we do not have sufficient numbers for a club, we then cancel the club, which enables the coach to find work elsewhere. A full refund will be given. Signing up by this date helps us to produce registers and class lists for children attending clubs in a timely manner. If the club is no longer on ParentPay this means the club has closed and you are no longer able to sign your child up for the club. If you have not signed your child up for a club on ParentPay, please do not send your child to the club.

Parents who usually use PayPoint should contact school; we will reserve your place and issue a letter to enable a payment to be made

**Children in Years 5 & 6 only**, will now be able to walk home after the club, once we have received written permission from the parent.

## **Behaviour**

### **By providing extra-curricular clubs we intend to:**

- Offer opportunities for fun and enjoyment through a range of activities
- Extend and enhance learning
- Encourage children to work cooperatively and across age groups

### **Whilst attending clubs, children are expected to:**

- Use socially acceptable behaviour
- Respect one another, accepting differences of race, gender, ability, age and religion
- Choose and participate in a variety of activities
- Ask for help if needed

### **Positive behaviour is encouraged by:**

- Staff acting as positive role models
- Praising appropriate behaviour

### **Dealing with inappropriate behaviour**

- Activity leaders are paid to offer additional opportunity. They should not be asked to do this whilst managing inappropriate behaviour. We expect all our children to behave appropriately whilst attending an after-school club.
- Staff will explain why the behaviour displayed is deemed inappropriate
- Staff will consult with parents to formulate clear strategies for successful participation.
- If poor behaviour continues, the child will be asked to stop attending the club

If after consultation with parents and the implementation of behaviour management strategies, a child continues to display inappropriate behaviour, the Club may decide to exclude the child. The reasons and processes involved will be clearly explained to the child and their parent/carer.
