Dear Parents and Carers,

Taped up areas of school

It is highly likely you are aware that some areas of the school site have been taped off and are, for now, out of bounds. In answer to some questions in passing conversations, they are not crime scenes!

This week, a section of the wall which separates Mission Possible from the woods collapsed overnight. The reason for this is currently unknown. Then, as part of our regular site inspections, we noticed that part of the wall at the front of the school was bowing inwards. All relevant colleagues at Kirklees have been informed and we are awaiting guidance once site visits have taken place. In the meantime, the areas will remain taped off as a precaution.

As such, Mission Possible is not to be used at any time before, during or after school nor is the playground at the front of the school. We will update you as soon as we have further information. For now, Years Three and Four will use the 'bottom door' off the main playground to enter and exit the building.
